



Specific Terms & Conditions Aquatech China 2021

These specific Terms and Conditions for Event Participation (the Specific Event Terms) apply to participation in Aquatech China 2021 (the Event) In addition to these Specific Event Terms, the Standard Terms and Conditions of Event Participation (the Standard Event Terms) also apply. Terms in these Specific Event Terms with a capital letter have the same definitions given to them in the Standard Event Terms.

Organisation

The Event is organized by RAI and Shanghai CHC Exhibition Co. Ltd (**Partner**).

Venue and dates

The Event will be held in the National Exhibition and Convention Center, No.333, Songze Avenue, Shanghai, China (the **Convention Centre**) from Wednesday 2 June up to and including Friday 4 June 2021.

Opening hours

The Event will be open to visitors on:

Wednesday 2 June 2021 09.00 A.M. – 05.00 P.M.

Thursday 3 June 2021 09.00 A.M. – 05.00 P.M.

Friday 4 June 2021 09.00 A.M. – 03.00 P.M.

For Participants, the Convention Centre will be accessible from 30 minutes before the opening until 30 minutes after the closing of the Event.

Construction and dismantling period

The halls in the Convention Centre will be open for stand construction and preparation on Monday 31 May to Tuesday 1 June 2021 from 08.30 A.M. to 05.30 P.M. The Goods may be removed and the stands dismantled and taken away on Friday 4 June, from 03:30 P.M. to 08:30 P.M.

Event programme

Products and services are only authorised for display at the Event if, in the opinion of RAI, they conform the scope of the Event. Authorisation is at the full discretion of RAI, or any committee designated by RAI.

Participants

Participants may be manufacturers, representatives, importers, wholesalers, exporters, publishing companies and other service providers, as long as they are economically active in the field of Water Technology. Authorisation is at the full discretion of RAI, who may refuse exhibitors without incurring any liability.

Demonstrations

Special activities at stands, such as product presentations, performances and shows, may only take place if written permission is granted by the Organizers. Please note that permission must be requested in writing at the latest 30 days before the beginning of the construction period. This permission is subject to various conditions, including that the activity must be situated in such a way that interested visitors do not block the corridor.

Costs of Stand Space

The rental price per square metre of floor space is:

Municipal & Industrial segments:

Deluxe Zone: \$306,00 when booked before 1 Dec 2020, \$ 340,00 regular rate

Premium Zone: \$399,33 when booked before 1 Dec 2020, \$ 443,70 regular rate

Residential/POU segments:

Deluxe Zone: \$314,67 when booked before 1 Dec 2020, \$ 349,63 regular rate

Premium Zone: \$405,33 when booked before 1 Dec 2020, \$ 450,37 regular rate

* For all stand spaces of 15 m² and smaller the use of at least a **Deluxe shell scheme stand** from the Organizers is **mandatory**.

Manual

The Organizers will send a manual to the Participant including rules for exhibitions in China and other practical information (the **Manual**). In addition to the Standard Event Terms, the Manual is added to article 18.3 as sub f of the Standard Event Terms.

Stand construction

The above-mentioned rental fee per square metre of floor space excludes the cost of shell scheme stand construction. Participants who do not wish to construct their own stand may order shell scheme stand construction, thus saving labour and costs of transport etc.. We offer 2 different types of shell scheme construction: Deluxe and Premium shell scheme stand. For prices and all further information please refer to the application form of Aquatech China 2021. Deluxe shell scheme cannot be ordered in Premium Zone locations.

Participants who do not wish to use shell scheme stand construction must ensure that the stand complies with the Stand Build-up Rules of the Event. RAI will make the Stand Build-up Rules available to the Participants upon first request. Participants who do not use the shell scheme stand construction must send their design of the Stand Space (in the form of a clear scale drawing or on the basis of a scale model accompanied by a single scale drawing) to RAI (or to a party designated by RAI) for approval no later than 50 days before the Event. RAI has the right to withhold approval. In such a case the Participant should modify the design of the Stand Space within a period specified by RAI in such a way that approval can be granted after all. Any approval will be given in writing.

Cancellation and stand reduction

In deviation of article 3.1 of the Standard Event Terms, Requests by a Participant to cancel or change a Participation Agreement (i.e. to reduce the number of square metres of Stand Space) may be submitted in writing or by email. RAI may grant such a request on condition that the Applicant in any event pays the subsequent cancellation fee, which is based on a fixed percentage of the Participation Costs

- upon cancellation until 1 January 2021: free of charge;
- upon cancellation in the period from 1 January until 1 March 2021: 50% of the Participation Costs;
- upon cancellation in the period from 1 March until 1 April 2021: 75% of the Participation Costs;
- upon cancellation in the period from 1 April 2021 to 32 days before the first build-up day of the Event: 100% of the Participation Costs;
- upon cancellation in the period up to and including 31 days before the first build-up day of the Event: 120% of the Participation Costs;

or such higher amount as is due in the RAI's opinion as compensation for the costs incurred or yet to be incurred as a result of the cancellation or amendment.

Terms of Payment

The Participation Costs should be paid in accordance with the provisions of article 7 of the Standard Event Terms.

In derogation of the Standard Event Terms, no Application Fee will be charged.

In derogation of article 2.8, the Participant shall have the right to cancel the Participation Agreement, free of charge, until payment of the 1st invoice is due as set out in the relevant invoice, usually 21 days (the Cancellation Term). The Participation Agreement may be cancelled during the Cancellation Term by sending an email to RAI at the email address specified in the Specific Event Terms. After the Cancellation Term, the Participation Agreement may only be terminated subject to payment of the cancellation fee set out in these Specific Event Terms.
